- 3. The Douglas Lake Ranch is Canada's largest working cattle ranch
- 4. Merritt's first outdoor art sculpture was the Wind Onion located at Lions Memorial Park
- 5. Merritt is home to the Merritt Centennials, the longest continuously run franchise in the BC Hockey League
- 6. There are over 200 lakes within an hour drive of Merritt
- 7. The Murray Church is one of the most photographed churches in British Columbia
