Where do we find public restrooms?

Going East on Hwy 97C towards Kelowna

- 1 Highway 97C Loon Lake Rest Area (37 km east of Merritt).
Open 24 hours. Flush toilets.
Accessible facilities. Wifi.
Picnic area. Bus access.

- 2 Okanagan Connector Visitor Centre (101 km east of Merritt).
Open May - mid-October.
Accessible facilities. Wifi.
Snacks. Bus access.

Going Southwest on Hwy 5 towards Vancouver

- 3 Britton Creek Rest Area (67 km south of Merritt).
Open 24 hours. Flush toilets.
Accessible facilities. Bus access.

- 4 Coquihalla Lakes Rest Area (Former Toll Booth) (70 km south of Merritt).
Open 24 hours. Flush toilets. Accessible facilities.
Bus access.

Going North on Hwy 5 towards Kamloops

- 5 Walloper Rest Area (64 km north of Merritt).
Open 24 hours. Flush toilets. Accessible facilities.
